

Bio Data - Mafiul Hussain, IFS

- Belongs to the 1980 batch of the Indian Forest Service.
- Allotted Maharashtra cadre.
- Belongs to Nalbari, Assam.
- Did schooling in Nalbari initially and then in Mount Hermon School, Darjeeling.
- Thereafter did B.Sc. Honours in Botany from Hans Raj College, University of Delhi from 1974 to 1977 and M.Sc. Botany from the Department of Botany, University of Delhi from 1977 to 1979.
- Joined IFS in April 1980 as per exam held in 1979. After formal 2 years training in the Indian Forest College (now Indira Gandhi Academy), Dehradun and 3 months Foundation Course at the Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration, Mussoorie.
- Joined the Maharashtra State in 1982 and worked in various districts like Thane, Gadchiroli, Pune , Parbhani and Greater Mumbai. Was on Govt of India deputation for 5 years.
- Most recently he has worked as Joint Secretary, Tribal Development Dept; Secretary , State Information Commission and Secretary, State Human Rights Commission. He was promoted as Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, RET, Pune, in the grade equivalent to Additional Chief Secretary in April, 2014 and continues in that post.
- Shri Mafiul Hussain has done MBA (HRD) from Jamnalal Bajaj Institute of Management Studies, Univ of Mumbai in 2004-2007 (part time). Currently he is doing his Ph.D. in Human Rights from Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai.
